

Case Manager Consultation And Resource Room Supports

All Allen Park Schools offer special education support on a case manager consultant basis, and in the form of resource room for those students who need that level of support. Case manager consultant service involves a student's case manager working in partnership with general education teaching staff to help support student achievement. Resource Room Support is for students who are special education eligible and who have been determined to need an additional level of support beyond consultation. Resource room classes are taught by a special education teacher.

At the elementary level, Resource Room is typically offered as a pull-out service in the areas of English Language Arts and Math. At the Middle School and High School, Resource Room expands to program for students in the areas of Science and Social Studies. Our Middle and High Schools also offer some push-in resource services in the form of co-teaching. Co-teaching involves a resource teacher supporting and co-instructing a group of special education students who are mainstreamed into a general education classroom setting.

Please know that Allen Park's students are taught to Michigan Grade Level Core Content Expectations and High School Content Expectations, regardless of whether they are in a general education classroom or a resource room. Please also know, however, that accommodations may be necessary for some special education eligible students to better access the curriculum and/or demonstrate their knowledge of that curriculum.
