Eufaula City Schools had three class-size reduction teachers funded by Title II. Three teachers were assigned to Eufaula Elementary. The addition of these teachers helped to provide a lower pupil/teacher ratio in the fourth and fifth grades: fourth 23.9:1 and fifth 23.8:1. Title II funds were also used to provide professional development opportunities for all teachers and administrators as well as highly qualified certification reimbursement.

Building Based Student Support Teams (BBSST) composed of teachers and administrators were available in every school. The highly qualified teachers, small class sizes, and BBSST teams in all Eufaula City Schools have impacted learning so that the number of students meeting or exceeding state standards in reading and math is increased each year.
