THE SCHOOL

Maranatha Academy was founded in 1974, and is an independent community Christian school.

Maranatha Academy's High School campus is located at 6826 Lackman Road in Shawnee, Kansas.

These modern facilities include a complete library, fully equipped science laboratory, a band room, computer lab and air-conditioned classrooms.

Maranatha is fully accredited by the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI), North Central Association (NCA), The Commission on International and TransRegional Accreditation (CITA), and National Council for Private School Accreditation (NCPSA) Maranatha welcomes students of any race, color, national or ethnic origin.

The educational philosophy of Maranatha Academy springs from the belief of its supporters and staff that all life is originally the product of a loving and holy God, and that the duty of man is obedience to that God and His principles. We believe that to educate for life, while ignorant of the source of life and His view of life, is futile and empty at best, destructive and perverse at worst. Therefore, it is the desire of the faculty, parents and students at Maranatha to know Jesus Christ personally and make Him known. With the guidance of the Holy Spirit, we want to incorporate the Word of God into all academic pursuits.

The essence of the educational philosophy at Maranatha Academy can be found in Colossians 1:28-29: "We proclaim Him, admonishing and teaching

everyone with all wisdom, so that we may present everyone perfect in Christ. To this end I labor, struggling with all His energy, which so powerfully works in me." It is our goal to help bring every student into full maturity in Christ. In short, we have been called to be those who are "**Loving and leading the next generation**" of God's children.

ADMISSION STANDARDS

Parents should be in agreement with our basic objectives and should be willing to actively support our educational program.

The student must have a sincere desire for a Christian education, and be willing to submit to the standards and regulations of our school.

The applicant's entering record of behavior in his home, community, school and church must indicate that we at Maranatha can be reasonably sure that the applicant's citizenship in our school will be acceptable.

Applicants entering grades 7-12 must attest to a definite born-again experience and give evidence of a daily relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ.

The student must be of suitable age for the grade assigned.

A student transferring from another school must be in good academic standing. Should the student's accomplishments be below his grade level as evidenced by recent grade reports and/or standardized achievement test scores, the child may be admitted on a probationary basis, or placed in a lower grade better suited for the student's achievement.

APPLICATION TIME TABLE

Initial inquiries are welcome at any time. Visits to the campus include a tour, classroom visits, and the opportunity for questions and answers with a representative of the Admissions Office.

Decisions on applicants are made from March 1st until all spaces are filled. Students who wait to apply during the summer months face a much more competitive admissions situation.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

1. Mail all transcripts (or grades) for 6th-11th grades and standardized tests scores within the previous two years.
2. Completed enrollment forms.
3. The \$45.00 non-refundable application fee.

Upon receipt and confirmation of these materials, you will be scheduled for an interview.

ACADEMIC PROGRAM

Specific course requirements for our High School students include 4 years of English, 3 years of Mathematics, 3 years of History, 3 years of Science, 2 years of PE, 2 years of Foreign Language, and 4 years of Bible.

Open registration will be made available to homeschooled students in Grades 7-12 who elect to take one to three courses per semester on a space-available basis. If the student has a gap of one hour between two selected courses, they may attend a study hall between

classes at no additional cost. The use of the library is available to homeschooled students while on campus except when a class is being held.

Available classes are Art I, Art II, Band, Choir, Spanish, Drama, Junior High Mathematics, Geometry, Algebra 2, College Algebra/Trigonometry, Calculus, Bible, Junior High History, World History, US History, Government, Earth/Space Science, Biology, Advanced Biology, Physics, Chemistry, Various Computer Classes.

Our grade reports are sent home each semester to parents in the Junior High/High School.

DRESS CODE REQUIREMENTS

All homeschooled students must meet Maranatha dress code. Clothing and appearance have a great influence on attitude, behavior, and school work. This standard of dress code is based on being neat, clean, modest, and appropriate for the occasion while prohibiting items which disrupt or distract from the educational goals of the school.

It is important to realize that our choice of clothing is important because it speaks to others before we may speak. This standard applies when you enter the school building, while in the building and until you leave the building. This applies Monday through Friday on school days and at all school activities.
