

# Preface to the Twelve Non-Negotiable Rules and Regulations for High School Students

**Respect yourself:** Do only those things that will help you achieve a successful and healthy future.

**Respect your associates:** Treat your associates with courtesy, justice, and truthfulness.

**Respect Property:** Take care of your things and the things that we all share.

## The Twelve Non-Negotiable Rules and Regulations

1. Attend school daily and come on time. (See Attendance Policy and The Eagle Way)
2. Outer clothing (i.e. winter jackets, overcoats...) are not permitted in the classroom.
3. Enter the classroom quietly, take your seat, and begin work immediately.
4. Be prepared to work every day. Bring whatever supplies are required for learning.
5. Complete all assignments to the best of your ability.
6. Cafeteria food and lunches must be consumed in the cafeteria.
7. Electronic communication devices, cameras, radios, etc. must be turned off and put away once a student enters the building. Cell phones may only be used after the school day concludes at 2:29pm.
8. Respect all staff members. In addition to the teaching staff and administration, staff members include the custodians, cafeteria workers, monitors, teachers assistants, classroom aides, etc...) They are here to help you succeed by keeping a positive, safe, and orderly learning environment for ALL.
9. Any physical or verbal violence is strictly prohibited. Learn to disagree without being disagreeable. Anyone involved in a physical conflict will be referred to the judicial system in addition to any suspension or expulsion from school.
10. Respect the building. Keep your school area clean and presentable.
11. Follow the school dress code. When you come to high school, you are coming to a place of business. Our business is you academic success. Show pride in how you present yourself.
12. Follow all aspects of the Student Code of Conduct. It is your responsibility to become familiar with all aspects our how we govern our learning community. If you are unsure, please ask questions for clarification.

Consequences are detailed in the code of conduct. However, they may include any or a combination of the following:

- Responsibility Plan
- Conference with involved teacher
- Conference with teacher, parent, and student
- Conference with administrator, teacher, parent, and student
- Out of School Suspension
- Superintendent Review Hearing
- Recommendation for Expulsion
- Community Service and/or Outside Counseling and Support Services
- Placement in an alternative learning program
