The President of the Board stated that the purpose of this meeting was to conduct a hearing to deliberate and to reach a decision on the possible expulsion of a student from the South Redford School District, as provided for in the Policy #1410(2) of the Board Policy Manual (Michigan's Open Meeting Law, Section 8C of Public Act 267, as amended by Public Act 256 of 1978.) Ms. Laurie Hicks asked the parent and student if they would like to move into closed session. The parents asked for the hearing to be in closed session.

Said student is hereby expelled from the South Redford School District for a period of one hundred and eighty school days effective January 29, 2010 for violation of the School district policies and for assaulting a teacher. This expulsion decision is also made pursuant to MCLA 380.1311a. Said student or his parents may petition for reinstatement after the conclusion of the one hundred and eighty school day period. The petition for reinstatement may be filed prior to the expiration of the expulsion period. A copy of this resolution shall be filed in the student's file.
