

Vaccination Clinic

WHEREAS, the new Jersey Department of Health and Senior Services has allocated funds from CDC for Public Health Emergency Response in Burlington County so that the Burlington County Health Department can provide an accelerated voluntary vaccination campaign for H1N1 Pandemic influenza; and

WHEREAS, vaccination is the best way to protect the population from this potentially serious disease and the Burlington County Health Department is currently making plans to immunize the targeted populations as designated by CDC, particularly children, pregnant women, health care workers and certain age individuals with underlying conditions in the first phase; and

WHEREAS, vaccinating children (and other indicated groups) at school can help meet the demand for convenient, timely vaccination while decreasing the burden on local health care providers who may be busy treating those infected with 2009 H1N1 and/or seasonal influenza; and

WHEREAS, the School Board Vaccination Program is voluntary and provides vaccine free of charge to students and other persons in the indicated groups and the Burlington County Health Department is committed to a School Based Voluntary Vaccination Program; and

WHEREAS, the School Based Vaccination Program can decrease the financial burden on parents and guardians and also decrease time away from work for these parent and guardians; and

WHEREAS, the Health Department will provide Licensed Vaccinators to accomplish this task in school, during school hours and has developed a template clinic plan, supporting documents, provided training to school nurses and school superintendents in support of the vaccination program; now, therefore, the Board
