With one application, a voter may request to receive a ballot for a single election, or for all elections in the current year. With that one application, a voter can receive a ballot for every subsequent general election, as long as the voter wants.

In New Jersey, any voter can now vote by mail in any election. *You do not need a reason to Vote by Mail.* Don't feel like going to the polls? Simply vote by mail. *Now there is "no excuse" not to vote!*

A voter may vote by mail by completing the **Application for Vote by Mail Ballot** (see below), and returning the application to their County Clerk (*County Clerk addresses attached to form*). To receive your ballot by mail, the application must be received by the County Clerk 7 days prior to the election. A voter may also apply in person to the County Clerk until 3:00 p.m., the day before the election.

The County Clerk **cannot accept faxed or emailed copies of a Application for Vote by Mail Ballot, unless you are a Military or Overseas Voter, since an original signature is required.**

VOTING INFORMATION

1. You must be a registered voter in order to apply for a Mail-In Ballot.
2. Once you apply for a Mail-In Ballot, you will not be permitted to vote by machine at your polling place in the same election.
3. You will receive instructions with your ballot.
4. Your Mail-In Ballot must be received by the County Board of Election before close of polls on Election Day.
5. Do not submit more than one application for the same election.
6. You must apply for a Mail-In Ballot for each election, unless you designate otherwise under "Voter Options."

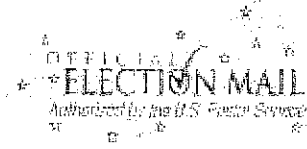
PLEASE NOTE

A voter may apply for a Mail-In Ballot by mail up to 7 days prior to the election. He or she may also apply in person to the County Clerk until 3 P.M. the day before the election.

Note also that voters have an option of indicating on an application for a Mail-In Ballot that they would prefer to receive a ballot for each election that takes place during the remainder of the calendar year.

Voters also now have an option of automatically receiving a Mail-In Ballot for each General Election. If such voter no longer wants this option, the County Clerk's office must be notified in writing.

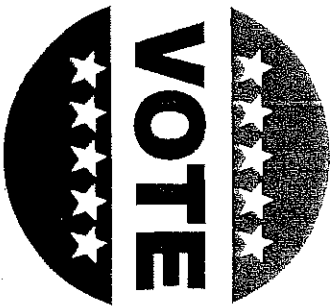
