- + Parents are reminded to call the school nurse between 8:00 a.m. and 9:45 a.m. anytime their child will be absent from school, or arrive late to school. Please let the nurse know the reason for your child's absence. Parents of a child who is absent from school and from whom we have not received notification will be contacted by the school nurse.
- + If it is necessary for your child to arrive late to school, a parent **must accompany the child to the office and sign the Daily Attendance Log.**
- + Please note that any child that is at home ill or sent home ill with a fever, vomiting, or diarrhea, must be without these symptoms for 24 hours before returning to school. Any student being treated for a Strep Infection must be on their medication for 24 hours before returning to school.
- + Medication may NOT be administered in school without a doctor's order and parent permission. This includes prescribed or over-the-counter medication. Please refer to the student handbook for other information concerning medication in school.
